Judas – the Apostle Who Betrayed Jesus

Son of Simon Iscariot

John 6:71

Iscariot – the man from Kerioth, a town near Jerusalem

Only Apostle from Judea; other were Galilean.

Listed Among the Twelve

“Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; the first Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother; Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James the son of Alpheus; and Lebbeus, whose surname was Thaddeus; Simon the Canaanite; and *Judas Iscariot*, who also betrayed him.” Matthew 10:2
