#### Some Definitions:

Strongs: a delegate, a messenger, one sent forth with orders

Talmud: The apostle of any one is even as the man himself by who he is deputed.

### **Commissioned by Jesus**

"As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world." John 17:18

Strongs - Sent: persons sent with commissions

### The Commission of the Apostles

"And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature." Mark 16:14

### **Especial Witnesses**

" The twelve traveling councilors are called to be the Twelve Apostles, or *special witnesses* of the name of Christ, in all the world; thus differing from other officers in the church in the duties of their calling. And they form a quorum equal in authority and power to the three presidents previously mentioned. The seventy are also called to preach the gospel, and to be *especial witnesses* unto the Gentiles and in all the world--thus differing from other officers in the church in the duties of their calling; and they form a quorum equal in authority to that of the twelve *especial witnesses*, or apostles, just named."
