There he worked with Zenos Gurley, Henry Deam, John Cunningham, Cyrus Newkirk, the Wildermuth family to name a few. At the time, they were Strangites.

At various times since 1856 efforts had been made by the eldership of the Church of Christ and of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints to form a working basis of harmony between them.

In 1897 overtures were again made by the elders of the Church of Christ. A joint committee composed of Elders from the Church of Christ and the RLDS church was formed. Joseph Smith III and Alexander H. Smith were among the elders representing the RLDS church.

Again in 1900 another joint committee was form including Joseph Luff, Heman Smith, Alexander H. Smith from the RLDS. They reaffirmed the series of agreements stated by the previous joint committee with clarifications made.

In 1917, the Church of Christ expressed a desire for further conferring. This led to the adoption of the "Agreements of Working Harmony" in 1918.

AGREEMENT OF WORKING HARMONY

In 1918, after many years of meetings and discussion the "Agreement of Working Harmony" between the RLDS and Church of Christ (Temple Lot) was adopted. Twenty-four points of agreement were agreed on. Point #7(listed below) addressed priesthood authority:

"Agreed, that we believe that there are individuals in the different factions who hold the priesthood."

The RLDS church formally adopted the "Agreement of Working Harmony."

"At a joint meeting of the First Presidency, Twelve, Seventy, High Priests, and Bishops held in the Church of Christ building on April 8, 1918, the report was considered paragraph by paragraph. Each of the twenty-four articles was approved and the document in total, was then approved unanimously."

Both churches formally adopted the "Agreement of Working Harmony."

The Church of Christ in their conference passed the "Agreement of Working Harmony" by unanimous vote

In the General Conference "the report was adopted with but one dissenting vote"

General Conference Minutes 1918, pg. 2611

"The *Spirit* of 'working harmony' is the important thing. The *letter* of the articles is of secondary importance and is chiefly useful in clarifying the situation."

Church History vol. 7 p.284

The day-to-day effect of the implementation of the "Working Harmony" agreement is described by an eyewitness.

"...the Elders of the Josephites (RLDS) preach for us. And our Elders preach in the Stone Church for the Josephites... We also take the sacrament together at either church,

and also use the same church books, Inspired translation of the Bible by Joseph Smith the Martyr. Also the same songbooks.

Last Sunday the president of our branch and other Elders from the Temple Lot was over to your church to hear President Fred. M. Smith, the son of Joseph, the son of Joseph, or the Grandson of Joseph the Martyr.

So you see we are indeed all brethren and co-workers with God for the building up of Zion and His cause upon the earth, and some day we will all come together and build the Temple."

"In the practice of the church in receiving members from different organizations, into which the original church was divided,

if a member shows a regular reception into the church under the hands of a regularly qualified minister, we have been quite willing to accept such persons on their original baptism."

Joseph Smith III con't:

"All baptisms performed prior to June 27,1844 have been held legitimate, and persons so baptized were entitled to be enrolled at their request.

Persons baptized after that date, if baptized by those holding priesthood who were not in transgression, we have been willing to accept also, and as a finality all to whose baptism the Spirit hath borne witness we have held it our duty to accept.

Joseph Smith III con't.

"The Book of Covenants teaches there are but two priesthoods; the Levitical or <u>Aaronic</u> and the <u>Melchisedec</u>."

Joseph Smith III con't:

"All, the officers of the church hold nothing more than these two priesthoods, though they may hold different offices, such as presidents, apostles, seventy, elders, priests, teachers, deacons, etc.

Joseph Smith III con't:

No one holds any higher priesthood than another in the Melchisedec. The same is true in the Aaronic."

In an editorial following the **1918** Conference, Elbert A. Smith listed four points that would **test for apostasy**.



1."...our Church of Christ brethren had established their claims so far as they may be involved in tracing baptism and priesthood back to valid original sources.

2. "As an organization they have held to the fundamental doctrines of the church."

Brother Elbert con't;



3. "...and have been guilty of no moral lapse.


4. "...in the face of adroit efforts to bribe and seduce from their trust they have kept themselves clear from evil forces and designing men."

Brother Elbert then concluded:



"...Hence no charge of apostasy from the original faith could be supported, were there any among us inclined at this time to make such a charge."

Jason W. Briggs indicated years later in sworn testimony that the RLDS church accepted the ordinations of individuals from the factional groups as legitimate from the office of deacon, teacher, priest and elder. The caveat was their ordinations were considered legal <u>if they were not involved in apostasy</u>.



"...The point was raised at that conference, and substantially decided, as I understood it, that James J. Strang and William Smith could ordain certain officers, could ordain elders, priest, and teachers. We derived that authority from the laws laid down in the books of authority in the church.

Ordinations by James J. Strang and William Smith to the office of seventies, high priests, apostles, or patriarchs, were not accepted...with one single exception...the office excepted was high priest."

INSPIRED MESSAGE THROUGH PATRIARCH VERNON DARLING APRIL 6, 2003 - AUDITORIUM IN INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI

This morning we were invited to come here to meet our Heavenly Father for His benediction. There has come to this servant of the Lord those spiritual indications that it is well that we have come together at this time. Our experience in coming here points to our need and our calling to be together, one body coming together under the principles of the Celestial Kingdom.

Our longing for God has to be a longing to prepare a place for Him in Zion. One of the truths of the gospel is that Zion will emerge. Only the person who seeks to bring forth and establish the cause of Zion, and walks in Zion's light, is aware of God in his experiences in life and understands Zion and lives for it.

We are called to be together under a shared sense of purpose and vision, not by our beliefs about specific behaviors. The call to purpose pulls us together but does not require that we shed our uniqueness. Zion does not ask its people to forfeit their freedom as a condition of belonging. Being clear about our purpose and vision will enhance the nature of our relationships within the Restoration Movement. Without a clear definition of common purpose our meetings serve only to increase our separation from each other.

We cannot exist without each other. We cannot get to a future that is worth inhabiting following separate paths. We have erected boundaries around us that have shut people out. Our fragmentation and separateness keeps us from being able to meet the needs of those who are hurting.

It is time when every person should have a voice in what we do and all have an opportunity to make decisions that affect the whole body. It is time to call a general assembly.




