The Gospel of the Kingdom

[Matthew 4:22] And Jesus went about all Galilee teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the **kingdom**; and healing all manner of sickness, and all manner of diseases among the people which believed on his name.

[Mark 1:12] Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the **kingdom** of God...

[ [Luke 4:43] But he said unto them, I must preach the **kingdom** of God to other cities also, for therefore am I sent.

[Luke 8:1] And it came to pass afterward, that he went throughout every city and village, preaching and showing the glad tidings of the **kingdom** of God; and the twelve who were ordained of him, were with him,

[Luke 9:1] Then he called his twelve disciples together, and he gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

[Luke 9:2] And he sent them to preach the *kingdom* of God, and to heal the sick.

[Matthew 10:6] And as ye go, preach, saying, The *kingdom* of heaven is at hand.

[Acts 1:3] To whom also he showed himself alive after his sufferings by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the **kingdom** of God;

[Acts 20:24] But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.

[Acts 20:25] And now, behold, I know that ye all, among whom I have gone preaching the **kingdom** of God, shall see my face no more.

[Acts 20:26] Wherefore I take you to record this day, that I am pure from the blood of all men.

[Matthew 24:32] And again, this gospel of the **kingdom** shall be preached in all the world, for a witness unto all nations, and then shall the end come, or the destruction of the wicked.

*[Matthew 6:10] Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.*

*[Matthew 6:11] Thy **kingdom** come: Thy will be done on earth, as it is done in heaven.*

[Helaman 2:96] And behold, the voice came again, saying, Repent ye, repent ye, for the **kingdom** of heaven *is at hand*; and seek no more to destroy my servants.

[Matthew 3:27] And in those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judea,

[Matthew 3:28] And saying, Repent ye; for the **kingdom** of heaven *is at hand*.

[Matthew 4:16] From that time, Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent; for the **kingdom** of heaven *is at hand*.

[Matthew 10:6] And as ye go, preach, saying, The **kingdom** of heaven *is at hand*.

[Sec 32:2f] ...open your mouths and they shall be filled, saying, Repent, repent and prepare ye the way of the Lord, and make his paths straight; for the **kingdom** of heaven *is at hand*;

[Sec 42:2d] and ye shall go forth baptizing with water, saying, Repent ye, repent ye, for the **kingdom** of heaven *is at hand*.



[Matthew 5:5] Yea, blessed are the poor in spirit, who come unto me; for theirs *is* the **kingdom** of heaven.

[Luke 17:20] And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them, and said, The **kingdom** of God *cometh* not with observation;

[Luke 17:21] Neither shall they say, Lo, here! or, Lo, there! For, behold, the **kingdom** of God *has already* come unto you.

[Luke 11:20] And if I, by Beelzebub, cast out devils, by whom do your sons cast out devils? Therefore shall they be your judges.

[Luke 11:21] But if I, with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the **kingdom** of God *has come* upon you.

[Matthew 26:26] But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I *shall come* and drink it new with you in my Father's **kingdom**.

[Mark 8:44] And he said unto them again, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they *have seen* the **kingdom** of God come with power.

[Luke 13:28] There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth among you, when ye *shall* see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and *you are thrust out*.

[Luke 13:29] And verily I say unto you, They *shall* come from the east, and the west; and from the north, and the south, and *shall* sit down in the **kingdom** of God;



**The Kingdom of God  
is the dominion where God rules as King,

**The Kingdom of God is where God is sovereign.**

[John 3:2] The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God; for no man can do these miracles which thou doest, except God be with him.

[John 3:3] Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

[John 3:4] Nicodemus said unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter the second time into his mother's womb and be born?

[John 3:5] Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water, and the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

[John 3:6] That which is born of the flesh, is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit, is spirit.

[John 3:7] Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

[John 3:8] The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth; so is every one who is born of the Spirit.
