RECOGNIZING THE NEED FOR GOD

This is the first fundamental area of spiritual growth

Here we are to:

- = Recognize the personal need for God in our life;
- = Not only recognize- but accept need for God to be the center of our lives;
- = Not only recognize & accept the need for God- but we need to demonstrate this through total, willing dependency on Him.

Our depth of dependency becomes our opportunity to have an intimate and personal relationship with Him:

- = Shift of strength from self to God
- = God initiates this period of growth by exposing Himself to us... "Because He first loved us."
- = This is one of God's invitations to prove Him "that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him"

Here begins our belief about God and His relationship with us. Building block for all future growth and joy.

UNDERSTANDING THE NEED FOR FOR FAITH IN JESUS

This 2nd area makes little sense unless one is settled and has found rest in dependency upon God.

- = Here one can discover their Redeemer; Advocate; Death; Rebirth; Divine Identity; and Grace.
- = Prayer becomes an expression of our faith in Christ.
- = Prayer becomes our willing expression of dependency on Jesus
- = We find God has initiated this area of growth by the free gift of grace.

The issue of sin, forgiveness, and righteousness become character references of our Redeemer and Saviour.

UNDERSTANDING THE COMPASSION OF CHRIST

Here we can discover the limitless and pure designs of holy compassion.

- = We find the arms of mercy are truly extended to all people.
- = Mercy becomes one of God's tools of compassion.
- = The power of mercy claims you and healings of both body and spirit are experienced.
- = Here we learn that all that God had initiated for us is our eternal example of how we are to treat others.
- = Herein rests His judgement upon us.

We are asked to become instruments of compassion unto a sin-sick and unbelieving world, that through you the world might see, and feel Jesus.

BECOMING CO-USERS OF GOD'S CREATIVE POWERS

Thus far we have accepted a life of dependency upon god, faith in Jesus Christ, have become a new creation in Christ, allowing Christ to live in and through us by the power of His love.

This area is truly one of unlimited Divine Trust towards those that have found their will "swallowed up in the will of the Father."

As Christ touched the three Nephites, so he can touch your life.

You truly know without any doubt that His power is sufficient for all your needs in all circumstances. He knows you will not take these creative powers and use them for your own personal gain;

RECOGNIZING THE NEED FOR GOD

- Heb. 11:6 ... For he that cometh unto God <u>must believe</u>

 that He is, & that <u>he is a Rewarder</u> of them that diligently seek him.
- -D&C: la&b ...the voice of him who dwells on high, & whose eyes are upon all men; ... Harken ye people from afar, & ye that are on the islands of the sea, listen together; ... the voice of the Lord is unto all men, there is no escape, and there is no eye that shall not see, neither ear shall not hear, neither heart that shall not be penetrated.
- -Heb. 4:13 ... all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.
- III Nephi 5:98... Pray unto the Father who is in secret; & thy Father, who seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly.
- Romans 10:12 ... For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek; for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him.
- Isaiah 51:1 Listen to me, you who pursue righteousness & who seek the Lord, look unto the rock from whence ye were hewn, & the hole of the pit from whence ye are digged.
- Ephesians 3:17 ... that ye being rooted & grounded in love;

 - v.6. He hath made us accepted in Christ.
 - v.7. We are redeemed by Christ's blood, ...forgiveness of sins according to the riches of His grace

David says it great!
-Psalms 139:14 I will praise thee; for I am fearfully & wonderfully made...

Paul writes to the Philippians he loved:

- Phil. 1:3 I thanked my God upon every remembrance of you.
 - v.4. Always in every prayer of mine, for the steadfastness of you all, making request with joy,
 - v.5. For your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now;
 - v.6. Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ.

By the doctrine of the Holy Spirit, Paul speaks:

- Eph. 2:10 For we are <u>his workmanship</u> created in Jesus

Christ unto good works, <u>which God hath</u> before ordained that we should walk in them.

Despite all God has intended, proclaimed, and set before us, He has allowed us to chose Him or reject Him.

Refer Back to Heb. 11:6-

Alma 16:46 ... Believest thou that there is a God?... Korihor & Alma -

A good example of today's view of God & our relationship with Him:

- Alma speaks to know of this:

Alma 16:47 ... Will ye deny again that there is a God,
& also deny the Christ? ... for behold, I
say unto you, I know there is a God, & also
that Christ shall come.

- v.49. ... I have all things as a testimony that these things are true; & ye also have all things as a testimony unto you that they are true, & will ye deny them?
- God speaks to Adam:
 - Gen. 6:66 All things have their likeness; & all things are created & made to bear record of me; both things which are temporal, & things which are spiritual; things which are in the heavens above, & things which are on the earth, & things which are in the earth, & things which are under the earth, both above and beneath, all things bear record of me.

Look at Korihor's philosophy (74 B.C.)

- Alma 16:16 Behold, ye can not know of things which ye do not see; therefore ye can not know that there shall be a Christ
 - v.17 Ye look forward and say, that ye see a remission of your sins. But behold, it is the effect of a frenzied mind: and this derangement of your minds comes because of the tradition of your fathers, which lead you away into a belief of things which are not so
 - v.18 ...every man fared in this life, according to the management of the creature; ...prospered according to his genius,
 - ... no crime
 - v.19 Lift up your head in your wickedness
 ...when man was dead, that was the end there
 of.

Examples of Korihor's (Satan's) philosophy today:

The attempt to live on our own strength is the world's futile attempt to provide self worth & success. The world teaches that dependency is a sign of weakness.

Alma knew this...

- Alma 13:46 And since man had fallen, he could not merit anything of himself;...

DEPENDENCY UPON GOD IS ESSENTIAL

- Ether 5:28 I give unto men weakness, that they may be humble; & my grace is sufficient for all men that humble themselves before me, & have faith in me, then will I make weak things become strong unto them.

Jesus speaks:

- Mark 10:24 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.
 - v.26. And Jesus, looking upon them said, With men that trust in riches, it is impossible; but not impossible with men who trust in God & leave all for my sake, for with such all these things are possible.
- -John 15:4-5 Abide in me, & I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.
 - v.5. I am the vine, ye are the branches. He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit; for without me ye can do nothing.

Deserts all God has begun, He gives agency to seek Him or reject Him.

- Psalms 103:ALL ...Forget not all his benefits
 - forgiveth all thine iniquities
 - healeth all thy diseases
 - redeemeth thy life from destruction
 - crowneth with loving kindness of mercies
 - hath not dealt with us after our sins
 - our transgressions are moved from us
 - He knoweth our frame -- dust
- II Nephi 6:53 And where there is no condemnation, the mercies of the Holy One of Israel have claim on them, because of the atonement: For they are delivered by the power of Him.
- II Nephi 1:73 no flesh can dwell in the presence of God, save it be through the merits, and mercy, and grace of the Holy Messiah.
- Jacob 3:15 ... He counseleth in wisdom, and in justice, and in great mercy, over all his works.
- Mosiah 13:27 ... the Lord worketh with His Power in all cases among the children of men, extending the arm of mercy towards, them that put their trust in Him.
- Alma 14:127 ... God is mindful of <u>every people</u>, in <u>whatso ever land</u> they may be in; ye, he remembered his people, and his bowels of mercy are over all the earth.

Alma 15:55 For I know that He grantethunto men according to their desire, whether it be unto death or unto life

Applies to mercy, justice, and judgement

See D&C 85:8-10

See Alma 16:216,217 >

- intent of Christ's sacrifice > to bring about (birth the inner power of) mercy.
- because mercy is more powerful than justice and allows man divine justification to have faith unto Repentance.
- -Mercy can satisfy the demands of justice
- -Cry unto Him that He would have mercy in you.
- Alma 19:14 Mercy claims the Repentant
- Alma 9:55 Whoso ever repents without a hard heart, shall have claim on mercy unto the remission of sins, and enter into His rest.
- Alma 16:135 He who repents, finds mercy.

See Alma 19:81-106-Great Example V. 113 & 114-

- Romans 15:17 Receive (accept) ye one another, as Christ has also received us -- to the glory of God
- Ephes. 4:32 Be kind, tender-hearted, forgiving, even as God has been to you
- Ephes. 5:1,2 Walk in love, as Christ loves you V.14 Awake and arise from the dead (unbelieving) and Christ shall give you light

IN THE GARDEN

(Window in Time #1)

Key Scriptures:

James 1:17 – "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, in whom is <u>no</u> variableness, neither shadow of turning"

- God is trustworthy & dependable, because He does not change from His word

Hebrews 13: 8 - "Jesus Christ the same vesterday, and today, and forever."

- Christ is trustworthy & dependable, and worthy of our dependency on Him

Genesis 1:19-22 — "God commands... eat of every tree except of the tree of knowledge of good and evil... God forbids that... if you eat of it, in that day you will die."

- A Spiritual death (or separation from God)

- Sin breaks good relationships with God, and others in everyday life

FALL OF MAN

(Window in Time #2)

Key Scriptures:

Romans 6:23 - "Wages of sin is death"

Mosiah 8:74-77 – "... Thus all mankind were lost; and, behold, they would have been endlessly lost were it not that God redeemed his people from their lost and fallen state..."

 Adam and Eve sinned against God's command – their sin affects and infects ALL people (all are fallen from God's presence; all of us need to be redeemed of our sin; God has a plan for us to come back into His presence)

We are all sinners, needing a Savior – Jesus Christ: True or False?

- What kind of God and Father would do this? - Answer: <u>A Loving Father</u> - who in your life loves you like God does? Mom, Dad grandmother, grandfather? How does their love affect you in everyday life?

- God's love can heal any sin, if we choose to follow His plan:

Question: What do you think it is? What is His plan for healing a sinful nature?

Answer: Repent, believe in Christ, be baptized in Christ, receive His Holy Spirit to guide you.

MERIDIAN OF TIME

(Window in Time #3)

Key Scriptures:

John 1:29 - "... Jesus Christ is the Lamb of God who taketh away the sin of the world."

MERIDIAN OF TIME (Window in Time #3) - continued

Jesus paid for your sins by dying for you, so you can live in God's presence again –
 What does this mean to you? And why?

Hebrews 7:26 – "...for He (Jesus) knows no sins, 'except' for the sins of the people. And this He did once, when He ,offered (used His own agency and love) up Himself." (to sacrifice His life on Earth for each of us)

 Useful Thought: Christ chose to give up His earthly life, so He could live <u>in</u> us, and by living in us, He can live His earthly life through us in our lives (the lives we live are <u>not our own</u>, but <u>Christ's</u> because of His sacrifice)

Question: Can you see Christ living out His life in the lives of His covenant people? Give examples.

(Window in Time #4)

Key Scriptures:

REMEMBER - Romans 6:23 - "The wages of sin is death."





[Alma 19:96] And thus we see that all mankind were fallen, and they were in the grasp of justice; yea, the justice of God, which consigned them for ever to be cut off from his presence.

[Alma 19:93] And now there was no means to reclaim men from this fallen state which man had brought upon himself, because of his own disobedience;



[Alma 19:104] But there is a law given and a punishment affixed, and repentance granted; which repentance, mercy claimeth: otherwise, justice claimeth the creature, and executeth the law, and the law inflicteth the punishment; if not so, the works of justice would be destroyed, and God would cease to be God.

[Alma 19:105] But God ceaseth not to be God, and mercy claimeth the penitent, and mercy cometh because of the atonement; and the atonement bringeth to pass the resurrection of the dead: and the resurrection of the dead bringeth back men into the presence of God;

[Alma 19:106] And thus they are restored into his presence; to be judged according to their works; according to the law and justice; for behold, justice exerciseth all his demands, and also mercy claimeth all which is her own; and thus, none but the truly penitent are saved.


