

Psalm 100

- Praise is like water to the growing plant of God's spirit.
- Praise is the natural response of a life
 that knows God's love. If we are rooted and grounded in His
 love, the natural response should be to praise and thank the
 Lord.

"Praise is the perfect preparation for our prayers"

- **Praise** and worship allow the seed of God's spirit to break forth, grow stronger and sustain growth. (Isaiah 61:10-11)
- **Praise** takes the focus off of ourselves and puts it on the Lord where our focus belongs. David didn't look at the huge giant. He looked at his huge God!
