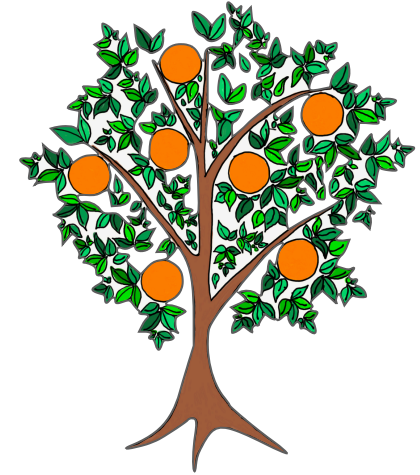


8a. Ask

Ask Part 1 - Daily Bread

Testimony: Bill Davies' family didn't have any food and they were hungry so his mother prayed for bread. She sent him to the basement to see if there was a loaf in the place she kept bread. Ask Part 2 - Not Led Into Temptation

Another part of asking is : Suffer us not to be led into temptation.

Discuss what that means. We all will have temptations in this life. Even Jesus was tempted!

The next part of the verse says:

But deliver us from _____. What word goes there? Evil.

Evil is something that is against God. It is something that leads us away from Him. Can you think of anything you are tempted to do that leads you away from love, joy, peace, patience, goodness, kindness...?

Our job is to believe God's Word and His love MORE than we believe the lies of the enemy. **(Look up Psalm 91)**

Put it into practice

- **First,** make sure you aren't inviting evil into the garden of your heart or into your house.
- **Ask God** to show you anything that would hold back the fruit of your prayers.
- **Then,** simply ask your loving Heavenly Father to help you not give into temptations and deliver you from evil!
- **Finally,** rejoice that He is such a big, big God that can do all things!
