Today's Devotion


The Bible says "Do not fear," so many times that some people say there is at least one verse for every day of the year. It's that important.


One of the main weapons of the enemy is **planting fear** in our hearts and minds.

and a **sound mind**.


2 Timothy 1:7

A Note for Parents & Teachers

This devotional is designed to help children learn that **God's love is stronger than fear** and that they can respond when fear tries to take root in their hearts.

Take your time with this. Read it with the companion story *No Fear in Love* by Becky Stayton. Spend some time reading and discussing. Look up the verses. Read together, talk simply, and invite children to share their thoughts and feelings.

If they are dealing with fears, pray about it together.

Encourage children to **say God's Word out loud**. Hearing Scripture spoken helps build faith, confidence, and peace.

Using the Scripture Memory Cards

- Focus on **one verse at a time** and encourage the children to keep it where they will see it often.
- Read the verse daily and repeat it together.
- When fear shows up, gently ask, *“What does God say about this?”*
- Use the blank card to let children write or draw their own favorite Scripture.

This devotional isn't about ignoring fear—it's about helping children trust that **God is with them** and has given them powerful tools through prayer, praise, and His Word.
